

# Rules for BCIAHA Year End High Point Awards

1. Horses must be registered with CAHR or AHA.
2. Participant must be either a Adult or Youth member of BCIAHA in good standing.
3. No nomination fee is required to participate.
4. The horse will stay qualified for annual awards if sold and the new owner is a BCIAHA member.
5. It is the member's responsibility to submit show results to the high point chairperson on or before October 31<sup>st</sup> of the year they are competing in. This will be strictly enforced.
6. Prizes will be awarded to the high point champion, reserve champion, and remaining top five.

## Completion of High Point Score Sheets

*\*\*Please read carefully; it is the participant's responsibility to make sure their high point score sheets are completed accurately\*\**

- Submit only a maximum of 4 best placings from each of your 4 best shows, rides or races (dressage participants can submit 2 best tests from each of their 4 best shows).
- A separate score sheet is required for each show, ride or race entered, which must be signed and have the phone number of an authorized official, executive or show secretary. An official printout of "horse competition records" from the AHA website will be accepted in lieu of signatures on the high point score sheets. This printout would include AHA recognized shows and results submitted under the AHA open qualifying competition program. \*\*You must still complete the high point score sheets\*\*
- A separate score sheet is required for each horse nominated.
- Points earned under the same judge in more than 2 shows will not be calculated.
- For those shows using multi-judging system, scores will not count- only final placings will determine points.

## Halter & Performance Calculations

- 1 point is earned for each horse defeated in open shows.
- 2 points are earned for each horse defeated in Class A shows.

## Distance Riding Calculations

- 1 point for each horse defeated in the race. Points are awarded up to 10<sup>th</sup> place.

	Level II	points X 1.5
	Level III	points X 2
<b>Endurance</b>	25 miles	points X1
	50 miles	points X2
	75 miles	points X 3 etc.
